Developing capacity with Southern partners can be achieved with the aid of various qualitative and participative Planning, Monitoring and Evaluation methods. Most Significant Change and Outcome Mapping are methods that were recently developed and can be of use in learning about process.

The *learning events* will provide basic insight into the methods. We are also offering two *Pitstops* in which we study each method in greater detail. Those with (more) experience with a method will be offered an opportunity to exchange knowledge and experience with others.

Learning events :

Outcome Mapping: 26 and 27 May (2 days with no overnight stay) enrol before March 27

Most Significant Change: 29 September enrol before 22 June

Pitstops :

Outcome Mapping: 9 June enrol before 27 March

Most Significant Change: 13 October enrol before 22 June

The number of participants is limited to two per organisation, so it is worth enrolling early!

Participation is free to staff members of PSO organisations and their Southern partners; staff of non-member organisations will be expected to contribute € 50 per day.
